






Zoom Audio 'Use Original Sound' – MacBook Pro (Zoom 5.4.7)




Open the Zoom App on your MacBook Pro. Now tap the Settings cog in the top right corner.



The setting menu will appear. Select Audio. Scroll down to the Music and Professional Audio section and ensure that Show in-meeting option to 'Enable Original Sound' from microphone is selected (white tick/check on blue background).



When you next join a meeting this pop-up will appear. Select Join with Computer Audio.



In the top left of the screen there should be a grey rectangular control button that reads 'Turn Off original Sound'. This means you are all set. If the button reads 'Turn On Original Sound', click it once to change to 'Turn Off original sound'.
